



LIFEGUARD JOB DESCRIPTION

SUMMARY:

Under general supervision, ensures the safety of patrons of an aquatic facility by preventing and responding to emergencies during the pool operating season (May-September).

SALARY:

\$11-\$13/Hour (depending on skills, certifications, and/or experience)

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintains constant surveillance of patrons in the facility; acts immediately and appropriately to secure safety of patrons in the event of emergency
- Provides emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of EMS (Emergency Medical Services)
- Presents professional appearance and attitude at all times, and maintains a high standard of customer service
- Performs various secondary duties as directed to maintain a clean and safe facility
- Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned
- Follows routine verbal and written instructions
- Enforces all pool rules and policies
- Follows all procedures, including implementing Emergency Action Plans

MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS:

- Red Cross Lifeguard Training Certification
- CPR for the Professional Rescuer Certification
- First Aid & AED Certification
- Must be dependable and able to coordinate schedule with supervisor
- Must be willing to work some weekends and holidays

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Ability to pass a pre-employment physical skills evaluation as stipulated by the department
- Ability to prepare routine administrative paperwork
- Knowledge of CPR and emergency medical procedures
