Climbing Wall

Certifications

All climbing wall users age 14 and older must participate in a safety orientation and certification with a staff member. We offer 3 certification levels (see back panel).

Pricing

Wall access and certification exams are included with all day passes and memberships. Lessons and clinics are available at extra cost (see CRCC seasonal program for details).

Lessons and Clinics

Lessons (private and group) are available to climbers with no prior experience who would like to address specific skills or earn a Level 2 or Level 3 certification. Skill-focused specialty clinics

Equipment Rentals

- Shoes can be borrowed at no extra cost any time from the front desk
- Harnesses can be borrowed at no extra cost during Facilitated Climbing Hours or scheduled classes and clinics ONLY.
- Lead ropes must be borrowed from the front desk. No extra fees required.

Facilitated Climbing Hours

2nd & 4th Wednesday of every month
6:30-8:30pm (Summer Hours)

Climbing wall staff available to complete Level 1, 2, and 3 certifications, issue equipment, and answer questions.
(Level 1 certifications can also be completed outside of Facilitated Climbing Hours)

Wall Regulations

CERTIFICATION OPTIONS:

All climbers must be certified to Level 1 or higher before using the wall (even if only bouldering)

Level 1: Bouldering Only

Can be completed with any staff member at any time. No prior experience necessary.

Level 2: Auto Belay and Top-Rope

Climbers must pass an instructor-led exam covering top-rope climbing, belaying, and auto-belay use.

Can be completed during Facilitated Climbing Hours, private lessons, and designated clinics.

Level 3: Lead Climbing

Climbers must pass an instructor-led exam covering lead climbing and belaying. Can be completed during Facilitated Hours, private lessons, and designated clinics.

CLIMBING WALL RULES

- All wall users must sign a climbing wall waiver. Parent/Guardian must sign waiver for those under 18.
- Climbers 6 and younger can climb only if belayed by their parent/guardian
- Climbers under 14 must be accompanied by a Level 1 certified climber age 14 or older to boulder, and may climb on top-ropes or auto-belays only if belayed and supervised by a Level 2 or 3 certified climber
- Climbers under 14 may only be certified to climb or belay independently if granted special permission from a climbing wall instructor.
- If climbing without a rope (i.e. bouldering), climbers may NOT climb with their feet any higher than their eye-level above the ground. Climbers are responsible for staying within their safe bouldering height, even if marked routes finish higher.
- No food or drink allowed in the climbing wall area.
- Do not walk or sit below anyone climbing on the wall. Do not climb above anyone, and be aware of benches, fitness equipment, and other hazards.
- Other rules may apply as posted or verbally issued.

Failure to uphold these rules and regulations or any other posted or verbally issued information may result in loss of climbing wall privileges.
